



CROWN OF JUDAH NATION: NATIONAL SECURITY PROTOCOL (Kingdom of Yahudah)

**“Righteousness and Justice Are the Foundation of Thy Throne.” -Tehillim (Psalms) 89:14
Divinely Ordained | Scripturally Governed | Spiritually Enforced**

SECTION I: PURPOSE & AUTHORITY

1.1 Purpose

This Security Protocol is established to:

- Guard the sanctity, citizens, and infrastructure of the **Crown of Judah Nation**,
- Ensure peaceful operations of all spiritual, tribal, and governmental affairs,
- Provide a framework for righteous defense, non-aggression, and lawful order.

1.2 Scriptural Basis

“If a thief be found breaking up, and be smitten that he die, there shall no blood be shed for him.” — Shemoth (Exodus) 22:2

“Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.” — 1 Corinthians 16:13

“He who has no sword, let him sell his garment and buy one.” — Luke 22:36

This Protocol is not a call to violence, but to **righteous preparedness**.

SECTION II: SECURITY DIVISIONS

2.1 The Watchmen of Yahuah (Internal Security)

- Spiritual guardians trained in discernment, prophecy, and de-escalation.
- Responsible for guarding sacred spaces, assemblies, women, and children.
- Must be fluent in Scripture, Torah-based law, and non-lethal defense strategies.

2.2 The Malakim Division (External Protection)

- Specialized security for diplomatic travel, tribal lands, foreign mission teams.
- Operates under **international law** and **ecclesiastical immunity**.
- Must document all incidents, operate with restraint, and report to the Elders' Council.

2.3 Temple Keepers (Cyber & Information Security)

- Protect spiritual and tribal data systems, registration logs, and communications.
- Responsible for blocking digital infiltration, surveillance, or hacking attempts.
- Scripture-based oath of confidentiality: "Let your yea be yea, and your nay, nay." — Matt. 5:37

SECTION III: CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SECURITY PERSONNEL

1. **Sanctify Yourself Daily** – Fast, pray, and guard your ruach.
2. **No Profane Speech or Prideful Spirit** – "He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of Elohim." — 2 Sam. 23:3
3. **No Bloodlust, No Vengeance** – "Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, saith Yahuah." — Rom. 12:19
4. **Honor the Unarmed** – Defend the weak; never provoke violence.
5. **Use Force Only to Preserve Life or Prevent Evil** – All action must be lawful and in line with Torah.

SECTION IV: LAWFUL POWERS OF SECURITY UNITS

4.1 Authority

Each security unit operates under:

- The spiritual jurisdiction of Yahuah,
- The governance of the **Council of Elders**,
- The legal framework of **COJIEEOY's Ecclesiastical Charter**.

4.2 Authorized Responses (Tiered)

- **Tier 1: Verbal De-escalation** – Scripture, calmness, reason.
- **Tier 2: Formation Defense** – Standing in righteous posture; intercession teams.
- **Tier 3: Physical Detainment or Barricade** – Only for imminent threat.
- **Tier 4: External Law Enforcement Referral** – If crime exceeds spiritual jurisdiction and must be reported under legal covenant.

SECTION V: SACRED LOCATIONS PROTECTION

1. **No Unauthorized Entry into Sacred Assemblies, Embassy Grounds, or Temple Zones.**
2. **All Events Must Have Security Presence Approved by the Elders' Council.**
3. **All Guarding is to Be Done in Prayerful Rotation—A Watchman's Shift Shall Be Scripturally Timed:**
 - 3rd Watch (Midnight–3AM) — "Deep calls unto deep."
 - 6th Hour Guard (Noon) — "At the heat of the day."
 - 9th Hour (Evening sacrifice) — Guard the gates.

SECTION VI: WEAPONRY AND EQUIPMENT POLICY

"Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith Yahuah." — Zechariah 4:6

Approved for Use:

- **Anointing oil, shofars, staffs, non-lethal deterrents** (pepper spray, baton, tasers)
- **Licensed and concealed firearms** ONLY with pre-approval from Chief Ambassador and Elder Council

- No automatic weapons, excessive armament, or military-grade hardware

SECTION VII: INTERNATIONAL COMPLIANCE AND NON-AGGRESSION POLICY

1. All Crown of Judah security operations must comply with:
 - **Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations**,
 - **UNDRIP**,
 - **U.S. Title 42 §1983 protections for religious organizations**.
2. No security personnel may engage in foreign soil operations without:
 - Proper diplomatic credentialing,
 - Letters of Ecclesiastical Commission,
 - Notification to host nation or allied tribal embassy.

SECTION VIII: TRAINING, SCRIPTURAL EDUCATION & DISCERNMENT

Every member of the Watchmen or Malakim Division must:

- Complete **Scripture Defense Training** (Tehillim, Torah, Prophetic books),
- Learn **de-escalation protocols**, legal rights, and righteous warfare,
- Recite and sign the **Oath of Spiritual Protection** annually.

SECTION IX: OATH OF SPIRITUAL PROTECTION

“I, a servant of Yahuah, do solemnly swear to guard the people of the Covenant, uphold justice, rebuke evil, and never raise my hand in pride or vengeance. My duty is to Yahuah, my weapon is the Word, and my honor is eternal. I will not defile the temple nor profane the name of my Elohim. So let it be sealed. Amein.”
