

CROWN OF JUDAH NATION: BILL OF RIGHTS

"Where the Spirit of Yahuah is, there is liberty." — 2 Corinthians 3:17

Adopted and Sealed by the Council of Elders in Sacred Assembly

PREAMBLE

We, the Nation of the Crown of Judah, being descendants of the House of Yashar'el and servants of the Most High Yahuah, establish this **Bill of Rights** to affirm and protect the sacred liberties endowed to us by the Creator. These rights are not granted by man, but by Yahuah Himself, and may neither be revoked nor diminished by any earthly authority.

ARTICLE I - RIGHT TO WORSHIP YAHUAH FREELY

Every citizen of the Crown of Judah Nation has the irrevocable right to:

- Worship Yahuah in truth and in spirit (John 4:24),
- Keep His commandments, feasts, and Sabbaths without interference,
- Reject idolatry, pagan systems, and false religious impositions.

"Thou shalt have no other elohim before Me." — Exodus 20:3

ARTICLE II – RIGHT TO SPIRITUAL AND TRIBAL SELF-DETERMINATION

Each member has the sacred right to:

- Declare their tribal identity according to spiritual lineage,
- Govern themselves by Torah law and the Constitution of the Nation,
- Refuse all affiliations or labels not aligned with the divine heritage of Yashar'el.

"You only have I known of all the families of the earth." — Amos 3:2

ARTICLE III – RIGHT TO LAWFUL TRAVEL AND MOVEMENT

No citizen shall be hindered from:

- Traveling freely within and beyond territorial jurisdictions for spiritual purposes,
- Assembling for worship, mission, or tribal gathering,
- Crossing man-made borders when on ecclesiastical assignment.

"And I will gather them from the ends of the earth." — Isaiah 43:6

ARTICLE IV – RIGHT TO PROPERTY, LAND, AND INHERITANCE

Every citizen has the right to:

- Own, reclaim, and inherit land under tribal or spiritual stewardship,
- Defend land from unlawful seizure or fraud.
- Live on the land in accordance with Torah without unjust eviction.

"The land shall not be sold forever: for the land is Mine." — Leviticus 25:23

ARTICLE V – RIGHT TO PEACE AND DEFENSE

All citizens have the right to:

- Live in peace, safety, and spiritual dignity,
- Be defended from physical harm, slander, and unjust arrest,
- Receive lawful security from tribal authorities when under threat.

"Yahuah is a man of war: Yahuah is His name." — Exodus 15:3

ARTICLE VI – RIGHT TO PRIVACY AND SANCTITY

Each home, tent, or dwelling of a Crown citizen is sacred. No entity shall:

- Enter without invitation, covenant warrant, or spiritual cause,
- Monitor, record, or interfere with spiritual gatherings unlawfully.

"Come, My people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee." — Isaiah 26:20

ARTICLE VII – RIGHT TO SPEAK, TEACH, AND PROPHESY

All citizens are free to:

- Speak the truth of Yahuah without censorship,
- Teach, minister, or prophesy under spiritual anointing,
- Expose falsehood and rebuke unrighteousness as led by the Ruach ha'Qodesh.

"Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet." — Isaiah 58:1

ARTICLE VIII – RIGHT TO REFUSE TYRANNY, COERCION, OR MARK OF THE BEAST

No Crown of Judah citizen shall be forced to:

- Accept globalist mandates, biometrics, or vaccine enforcement,
- Submit to satanic or beast systems of control,
- Renounce their spiritual sovereignty under Yahuah for benefits, identification, or access.

"And they loved not their lives unto the death." — Revelation 12:11

ARTICLE IX – RIGHT TO SPIRITUAL AND LEGAL DUE PROCESS

Every citizen has the right to:

- Be heard before the Council of Elders if accused,
- Present testimony, call witnesses, and receive spiritual counsel,
- Be judged righteously according to Torah—not by biased secular systems.

"One witness shall not rise against a man... at the mouth of two or three witnesses." — Deut. 19:15

ARTICLE X – RIGHT TO REDEEMANCE AND RESTORATION

All citizens have the right to:

- Teshuvah (repentance) and return to the covenant if fallen,
- Be restored to fellowship through proper cleansing and correction,
- Be remembered as part of Yahuah's everlasting remnant.

"I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely." — Hosea 14:4

FINAL CLAUSE

These sacred rights are not subject to repeal, nullification, or compromise by any man, state, or institution. They are sealed in the heavens and upheld by the **Council of Elders** under the authority of **Yahuah Elohim Tseba'oth**.
